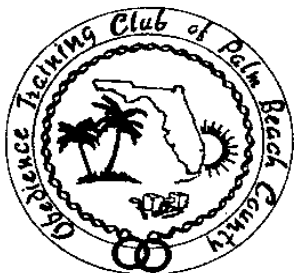

AKC Agility Course Test (ACT)

Saturday, March 4, 2017

ACT Evaluator: Mrs. Barbara Bounds, Judge

The AKC Agility Course Test is an entry level agility event designed to introduce beginning dogs and / or handlers to the exciting sport of agility. Dogs must be 15-months of age or older, physically sound, meet the requirements for a regular AKC agility trial (Chapter 1, Section 3), and may not hold any AKC agility titles, other than an ACT title. Dogs do not need to be registered with AKC to enter, however to receive a title certificate, a non-registered qualifying dog must complete the registration process and will receive instructions on how to do so.

ACT Level 1 is open to all dogs that have not earned any AKC agility titles. The course will have 10-12 obstacles to be completed within a maximum of 60 seconds course time. Obstacles include: 5' A-Frame, table, open tunnels, and bar jumps. Tire and panel jumps may be included. There are no spread jumps (double, triple, or broad jump), teeter, dog walk nor weave poles.

ACT Level 2 is open to all dogs that have not earned an AKC agility title except an ACT1 title. Level 2 courses will have 11-13 obstacles to be completed within a maximum of 70 seconds course time. Obstacles include those from Level 1 plus a teeter, 6-weave poles, tire, and one spread jump (double, triple, or broad jump); the dog walk may also be included.

Earning an ACT Title for either level requires two Qualifying runs with a minimum score of 85. Refusals and run-outs are not judged. More than 3 attempts at an obstacle will result in an elimination (non-qualifying) score. The rest of the faults are the same as in the regular agility classes. All passing scores may be from the same judge.

Dogs may enter any Jump Height division: 4, 8, 12, 16, 20, and 24" at the handler's choice. It is recommended that you enter the height at which you train. An AKC jump height card is not required, and dogs will not be measured at the ACT event. **Dogs may enter both Level 1 and Level 2 in the same Event.**

Entry Fees are \$15 per Run for Pre-Entry or \$18 per Run for Late or Day-Of Entry. Pre-Entry may be made via the club website or mailed to the Trial Secretary's address. **Pre-Entries close at 8:00pm Thursday, March 2, 2017.** Late and Day-Of Entries will be accepted until 8:00am Saturday, March 4, 2017.

Entries are Limited to 100 total runs per day.

Dogs May Arrive to the ACT Event prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Evaluators Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

Checks must be payable in U.S. Funds. RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$20.00 will be made for each returned check. **Overnight deliveries must be sent with no signature required at delivery.**

BITCHES IN SEASON will not be allowed on the grounds. Entry fee minus \$5.00 per first run and \$2 per additional run per Round entered will be refunded for bitches that come in season after the close of the event. The Trial Secretary must receive a veterinarian's written notification no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first run in the first class of the day.

Telephone or unsigned entries **WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side ***ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE***. NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as possible. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that: a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or if the event cannot be held or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, flood, disaster, Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes, or any other case beyond the control of OTCPBC. **Unentered dogs are not allowed on the trial grounds.**

There is a \$5.00 recording fee for each entry at an AKC ACT event. These fees are collected by the trial giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. Bench Show Committee will convene as a result of any damage to hotel, motel, show-grounds or to the premises or on complaints of abusiveness to judges, stewards, workers or dogs. All exhibitors are kindly requested to assist in maintaining the cleanliness of the facility and the grounds. We further request that you make the same effort for us at any hotel or motel you may be using. OTCPBC assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, visitors, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The welfare of children is the responsibility of the parents or guardian. They must exercise control and restraint over their children at all times. Any and all damages caused by the exhibitor, exhibitor's dogs or children will be the sole responsibility of the exhibitor.

INSTRUCTIONS

Dogs may be entered in any jump height. There is no Regular or Preferred distinction at AKC's ACT events.

In order to acquire the ACT1 or ACT2 title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered/listed with the American Kennel Club.

Dogs that are not AKC registered/listed may be registered at a later date and receive their ACT title at that time.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners program should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
